

PRIVACY NOTICE REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

This Privacy Notice has been prepared by **Trigemy Online Private Education Consultancy Services Inc.** (hereinafter referred to as the “**Company**”) in order to inform the Company’s customers regarding the processing of their personal data by the Company within the scope of the **Law No. 6698 on the Protection of Personal Data (“Law”)**.

a) Methods of Collecting Personal Data and Legal Grounds

Your personal data are collected through electronic means.

Personal data collected on the basis of the legal grounds specified in this Privacy Notice may be processed and shared within the framework of the personal data processing conditions set forth in **Articles 5 and 6 of the Law**.

b) Purposes of Processing Personal Data

Your personal data are processed by the Company within the scope of the personal data processing conditions specified in **Articles 5 and 6 of the Law** for the following purposes:

- planning and execution of activities required for the customization, recommendation, and promotion of the services offered by the Company according to the preferences, usage habits, and needs of the relevant persons,
- carrying out the necessary work by the relevant business units in order to enable the relevant persons to benefit from the services provided by the Company and managing the related business processes,
- performing the commercial activities carried out by the Company and executing the related operational processes,
- planning and execution of the commercial and/or business strategies of the Company,
- ensuring the legal, technical, and commercial security of the Company and the relevant persons who are in business relations with the Company.

c) Parties to Whom Personal Data May Be Transferred and the Purpose of Transfer

Your personal data may be shared, within the framework of the personal data processing conditions and purposes set forth in **Articles 8 and 9 of the Law**, with the Company’s business partners, suppliers, legally authorized public institutions and organizations, and legally authorized private legal entities for the purposes of:

- planning and executing activities necessary for customizing, recommending, and promoting the services provided by the Company according to the preferences, usage habits, and needs of the relevant persons,
- carrying out the necessary work by the relevant business units in order to enable the relevant persons to benefit from the products and services offered by the Company and managing the related business processes,
- performing the commercial activities conducted by the Company and executing the related operational processes,
- planning and executing the commercial and/or business strategies of the Company,
- ensuring the legal, technical, and commercial security of the Company and the relevant persons who are in business relations with the Company.

d) Rights of Data Subjects and the Exercise of These Rights

As personal data subjects, if you submit your requests regarding your rights listed below to the Company through the methods specified in the “**Trigemy Online Private Education Consultancy Services Inc. Personal Data Protection and Processing Policy**” available at www.trigemy.com, your requests will be evaluated and concluded by the Company as soon as possible and in any case **within thirty (30) days**.

Pursuant to **Article 11 of the Law**, you have the following rights as a personal data subject:

- to learn whether your personal data are processed,
- to request information if your personal data have been processed,
- to learn the purpose of processing your personal data and whether they are used in accordance with that purpose,
- to learn the third parties to whom your personal data are transferred domestically or abroad,
- to request the correction of your personal data if they are incomplete or inaccurately processed and to request that the transaction carried out within this scope be notified to third parties to whom the personal data have been transferred,
- to request the deletion or destruction of your personal data in the event that the reasons requiring their processing cease to exist, although they have been processed in accordance with the Law and other relevant legislation, and to request that the transaction carried out within this scope be notified to third parties to whom the personal data have been transferred,
- to object to the occurrence of a result against yourself by analyzing the processed data exclusively through automated systems,
- to request compensation for damages in the event that you suffer damage due to the unlawful processing of your personal data.
